# I.Q.A.C. Report

# Part - A

The Promises made in the first I.Q.A.C. Report on 2008 have been fulfilled to a great extent and what could not be achieved was due to lack of infrastructure. The plan of action chalked out at the beginning of this academic year (2008-09) towards Quality enhancement is as follows:

### Add - on-Courses :

- In Collaboration with Flying Cats, a professional organisation the college shall initiate for the students a training programme for Personality Development and Spoken English. It shall also provide Air Hostess Training.
- (b) In Collaboration with an NGO the college is offering. Basic Training in Computer Courses for students.
- (c) Yoga and Karate are not in the regular curriculumn of the college, but occasionally demonstrators visit the campus for special instructions on Yoga and Karate Classes for the benefit of the students.

### ☐ Vocational Courses:

- (a) A course on DTP & Physiotherapy training has been sanctioned by State Technical and Vocational Training (S TVT) under the Govt. of West Bengal. These two courses shall be launched from December, 2009.
- (b) A proposal has been sent for the introduction of B.Ed. Course, only for women in affiliation with Vidyasagar University. Procedural matter are in process.

### Study Centre at P.G. level:

- (a) The college is already holding classes at P. G. level of the Netaji Subhas Open University.
- (b) A Study Centre of Vidyasagar University, Directorate of Distance Education was opened on 14.12.08. Classes are being taken by outside as well as in house teachers. (For detailed information of a. & b. refer college prospectus, Page No. 14-17)
- (c) Application has been made for Convergence Course under IGNOU.
- (d) The college is considering the introduction of P. G. Course in the Department of Bengali under C. U.

### ☐ To fill up the vacant teaching posts:

Steps have been taken to fill up eight existing vacant teaching posts. The list of vacancies is being attached herewith (Page No. 5). New posts have been sanctioned in the departments of Hindi, Psychology, Sociology, Food & Nutrition, Chemistry and Journalism & Mass Communication.
